When the World Peace Flame was created in 1999 the dream was as simple as it is universal, one flame uniting all peoples of the world in peace.

Perhaps the most significant World Peace Flame is in The Hague in front of the Peace Palace, home of the United Nations International Court of Justice. It is surrounded by the World Peace Flame Pathway, where on the 27th April 2004, for the first time in history, a statement for peace was signed by 197 ambassadors representing all of the peoples of the world.

How wonderful it would be for us all to become the example of Peace to the world and to see this flame in every home, every school, every workplace, every place of decision making and every place of worship with the intention of Peace to All.

This evening you will receive a small tea light candle, lit from the WPF. You can light other candles from it and thus keep the flame of peace burning, and pass it on, with the simple intention of that one simple, yet special flame, uniting all peoples of the world in peace.
